# Support and Strengthen of Human Rights Defenders

In 2023, various forms of support were provided:

**124** individuals;













**9** organizations/initiatives;

**51** human rights defenders attended **5** thematic meetings;

Member or partner human rights defenders utilized the Human Rights House space **348** times for their activities. In total, **1626** people participated in these initiatives



# Advocacy and awareness raising in 2023

-  Co-organization of meetings held with the special rapporteur on UN Human Rights Defenders: three online sessions with Georgian human rights defenders;
-  Supporting meetings with Georgian human rights defenders during the official visit of the UN Special Rapporteur on Human Rights Defenders;
-  Prepared and sent three thematic reports using the UN special mechanisms;
-  Participation in the program to strengthen advocacy capacities within the institutions of the Council of Europe;
-  Participation in OSCE sessions and meetings addressing the topics of media freedom;
-  Participation in the founding of the anti-SLAPP coalition in Georgia;
-  The 'Lekso' award was given to five media professionals dedicated to human rights defense;
-  A communication platform for human rights defenders - Human Rights Fair;
-  Celebration of the International Human Rights Defenders Day, featuring a year-end summary, thematic reports from human rights defenders, and a screening of Lana Ghogoberidze's film
-  Fifteen open letters/statements and one thematic report on the situation of human rights defenders were prepared;
-  Membership and participation in the European Union Platform for the Temporary Relocation of Human Rights Defenders (EUTRP);
-  Supporting documentary films: Organized 13 film screenings with subsequent discussions, attended by over 300 people. DOCA monetary Award at CINEDOC / DOCA monetary Award at EsoDoc.
